#### **DECISION**

Pursuant to Article 104 and Article 155 of the Act of 14 June 1960 - Code of Administrative Proceedings (consolidated text: Journal of Laws of 2017, item 1257) in conjunction with Article 192, Article 378 section 2b of the Act of 27 April 2001 - Environmental Protection Law (consolidated text: Journal of Laws of 2017 item 519, as amended), having considered the request submitted by "3RE" sp. z o.o. sp.k., with its registered office in Choszczno, concerning the amendment of the waste generation permit, allowing for waste processing and collecting activities, in connection with the operation of the Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Recycling Plant [Zakład Przetwarzania Zużytego Sprzętu Elektrycznego i Elektronicznego] in Choszczno located at ul. Dąbrowszczaków 29 F, granted by the decision of the Marshal of the West Pomeranian Province of 31 July 2013 - reference number: WOŚ.II.7243.3.3.2013.IB, as amended

## I hereby decide as follows

to **amend** the decision of the Marshal of the West Pomeranian Province of 31 July 2013 - reference number: WOŚ.II.7243.3.3.2013.IB, amended by the following decisions:

- of 30 September 2013, reference number: WOŚ.II.7243.8.3.2013;
- of 9 April 2014, reference number: WOŚ.II.7243.6.1.2014.1 B;
- of 20 April 2015r., reference number: WOŚ.II.7243.3.2.2015.IB;
- of 28 July 2015, reference number: WOŚ.II.7243.7.4.2015.IB
- of 20 September 2016, reference number: WOŚ.II.7243.4.2.2016.IB

### in the following manner:

## 1. point 4 of the above decision shall read as follows:

"**Indicate** the number and name of the equipment group as well as examples of types of equipment from the groups of electrical and electronic equipment admitted to processing, in accordance with the following table:

Number of group	Types of electrical and electronic equipment and exemplary types of equipment belonging to groups of equipment			
2.	Screens, monitors and equipment including screens with surface area larger than 100 cm2 e.g.: Screens, television sets, digital LCD frames for photos, monitors, laptops, notebooks.			
3.	Lamps e.g.: Simple fluorescent lamps, compact fluorescent lamps, light emitting diodes (LED).			
4.	Large-size equipment with any of its outer dimensions exceeding 50 cm e.g.: Lighting fittings, sound or picture playback equipment, music equipment, with the exception of pipe organs installed in churches, mainframe computers, large-size printers, copying equipment, large-size coin-activated machines, large-size medical devices, large-size monitoring and control devices, large-size vending and cash machines, photovoltaic panels.			
5.	Small-size equipment with none of its outer dimensions exceeding 50 cm, in particular: household appliances, consumer equipment, lighting fittings, sound or picture playback equipment, music equipment, electrical and electronic tools, toys, recreational and sports equipment, small-size medical products, monitoring and control devices, dispensing machines, electrical current-generating equipment, vacuum cleaners, carpet sweeping equipment, calculators, radio receivers, video cameras, video equipment, hi-fi equipment, musical instruments, electrical instruments, bicycle, diving, running, rowing computers etc., heat regulators, thermostats, small-size electrical and electronic tools, small equipment with integrated photovoltaic panels.			

	Small-size IT and telecommunications equipment with none of its
	outer dimensions exceeding 50 cm e.g.:
6.	Mobile phones, satnavs, pocket calculators, routers, switches,
	personal computers, printers, telephones, clocks and watches,
	sound or picture playback equipment.

2. **in point 5 of the decision** of 28 July 2015, reference number: WOŚ.II.7243.7.4.2015.IB, after the first paragraph, **add** a **new paragraph** which shall read as follows:

"The Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Recycling Plant is equipped with:

- a weighing device equipped with a weight meter with a built-in memory allowing collective electronic print-out of all weighing operations carried out separately for waste equipment and separately for waste generated from waste equipment,
- a warehouse for equipment and elements to be re-used;
- containers placed by each manual dismantling station;
- materials (sorbents) used for preventing and eliminating potential leakages.
   Additionally, a specialist set for mitigating negative environmental impact of potential emergency situations connected with electrolyte or oil leakage is stored by a manager/warehouseman;
- vehicle manoeuvre area and car park which are connected to a coalescing separator,
- installations making it possible to recycle waste equipment generated from individual groups of equipment recycled in the specific recycling plant.
- 3. **in point 8 of the above decision**, replace the graphic appendix <u>with a new</u> graphic appendix, attached to this decision.
- 4. other terms and conditions of the above decision remain **unchanged**.

#### Justification

The decision has been issued on the basis of currently binding regulations, mentioned at the outset, and after having analysed the request of "3RE" sp. z o.o. sp.k. with its registered office in Choszczno at ul. Stargardzka 4, concerning the case in question. In the course of the proceedings carried out, pursuant to Article 155 of the Act of 14 June 1960 - Code of Administrative Proceedings (consolidated text: Journal of Laws of 2017 item 1257), a verification of the final decision in terms of admissibility of its amendment due to legitimate interest of the party has been carried out.

The amendment in question is connected with adaptation of the relevant permit to the requirements of the Act of 11 September 2015 on waste electrical and electronic equipment (Journal of Laws of 2015, item 1688). While amending the relevant decision, the authority has taken into consideration the party's demand which arose from the circumstances indicated in the above justification.

Recognising the request submitted as the basis for issuing this decision and that all works connected with correct operation of the installation will be performed in accordance with regulations in force in this respect, as well as that all terms and conditions of this decision will be fulfilled, **it has been decided as stated hereinabove**.

#### Instruction

The party has the right to appeal against this decision to the Minister of Environment via the Marshal of the West Pomeranian Province within 14 days from the date of its delivery. During the period for lodging an appeal, the party may waive the right to lodge an appeal to the public administration authority which has issued the decision. As of the date of serving the Marshal of the West Pomeranian Province with the statement on waiving the right to lodge the appeal by the party to the proceedings, the decision becomes final and legally binding.


